In terms of culture, history and sightseeing, this motorcycle tour is one of our best! The route we have chosen features four amazing countries, three spectacular cities, four different languages, dozens of amazing sights, several mountain ranges and an itinerary full of twisties and turns.

ABOUT THE ROUTE, THE SCENERY AND THE SIGHTS

After having landed at Munich International airport you will be greeted by the friendly Edelweiss tour guide which welcomes you on tour and takes you to the first hotel of your trip, where you can check in and then go to visit the BMW World in Munich. On the first riding day and after having packed the belongings you need during the day on your bike the group will start its way towards east. Heading out of Munich you will recognize less and less traffic and more and more beautiful vistas along the road. Quite soon, the first border on your tour will be crossed and the Czech Republic welcomes you with a nice sign. Reaching your first destination of the tour you may aim for a real Czech beer in the famous town of Budweis. The next morning, the route starts to go south and close to the next country of your tour - Austria. Via Wolfgangsee and Lienz you will be seeing beautiful landscape, fantastic sights and in the far distance even the foothills of the Alps which you will conquer together with the group.

From Austria, the route goes on to fascinating Bolzano which is bilingual and home to the famous ice mummy Ötzi. After a nice evening visit to town and with batteries being reloaded after some delicious Italian pasta you will - the next morning - ride around and across some of the highest mountain passes you may have seen in your life, including the famous Passo del Rombo. You may have to turn around and go up again as it is so beautiful there. In Seefeld, there is a so-called rest day which you can spend in any way you wish - you can sleep in and visit town, you can go on a half-day ride together with the group or you may just go straight to Garmisch and visit the BMW Motorrad Days event. From Seefeld, the tour will be over soon and once being back to Munich we will transfer you to the airport from where you can leave. It truly has been an ALPINE DELIGHT.

THE COUNTRIES YOU WILL BE VISITING

Beside the things you may know about the countries of our tour there is some interesting facts we wish to share and which - for sure - will make you smile and look forward to your visit:

GERMANY > The construction of Palace Herrenchiemsee, King Ludwig's palace on an island in Lake Chiemsee, cost 16 million „Goldmark“. He spent only nine days in the palace, so each day cost 1,777,777 Goldmark! Not surprisingly, he was taken into custody and declared „mad“ a little later.

CZECH REPUBLIC > People in Czech Republic are world champions in beer consumption and drink about 162 liter per person each year - on average. There is 470 different beer types you can taste!

AUSTRIA > That the Mozartkugel is a fine brand of Austrian chocolates which originated in Salzburg, Mozart's birthplace. In 1890, master confectioner Paul Furst made the first Mozart chocolates by forming small balls of marzipan which he coated in a praline cream and then dipped in warm chocolate. Other Viennese confectioners soon adopted the technique, and even today producers vie with each other to see whose Mozartkugel are the most authentic.

ITALY > That, at the end of the First World War, South Tyrol was ceded to Italy. After years of a policy of Italianisation and harsh political power struggles, the second South Tyrolean Autonomy Statute for the better protection of South Tyroleans came into force in 1972. People of Italian, Austrian and Ladin heritage now live here together in peace, cultivating their own culture.

HIGHLIGHTS



BMW WORLD

The BMW Welt has been open since 2008. If you like the Bavarian cars and motorcycles - this place should be on your agenda. The museum lets you walk through BMW's history: starting with airplane engines, it shows you all the milestones that BMW has produced since 1916!



GROSSGLOCKNER HIGH ALPINE ROAD

The Großglockner road takes us to the very heart of the Hohe Tauern National Park, the largest national park in the European Alps. It was built during an economic crisis in only five years (1930-1935) by more than 3,000 workers. In this park you find an incredible variety of plants and animals. At the peak of this toll road we become part of the 1.2 million visitors a year. You will be impressed by the scenery of peaks, glaciers and waterfalls.



BOLZANO

Since the town's foundation over 800 years ago, Bolzano has been a trading point. The main reason for this was its location in between the two major cities of Venice and Augsburg. Four times a year a market was held and traders came from the south and the north. Every market season, two Italian and two German officers (appointed from the traders who operated there) worked in this office. The city was a cultural crosspoint at that time.



PASSO DEL ROMBO

Long before the road was completed in 1969 people used the Timmelsjoch to cross the mountain range known as the Ötztaler Alps. It is the second highest pass in the eastern Alps (after Stelvio) and covers a vertical distance of more than 1,800 meters (6,000 ft). Especially the Italian (southern) side is quite spectacular to ride, the views are breathtaking. In April 2016 Europe's highest motorcycle Museum opened its doors to the public, displaying a collection of 190 vintage bikes.



BMW MOTORRAD DAYS

BMW Motorrad Days is the annual meeting of BMW motorcyclists, usually held in Garmisch-Partenkirchen. It's a 3-day event of stunt shows, test rides, festive ambience and camaraderie that in 2018 has brought together 35,000 enthusiasts. It attracts lots of motorcyclists from the Alpine area but also from far away such as East Asia and North America.

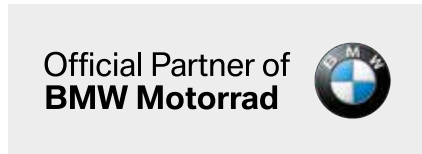
